Good Morning Church,

In our study of the Corinthian church, God through Paul has been sharing various examples of what the lives of spiritually immature believers look like. A major contributing factor in becoming a carnal Christian today is a lack of spiritual disciplines.

When we use the term "**Spiritual Disciplines**" what are we talking about? The following are some thoughts I found from Sermon Central that are worth sharing with you:

Here are some areas of spiritual discipline, ask the Lord if perhaps there is an area to practice and implement into your life. Remember there is no rule or checklist with God, ask him and be sensitive to his leading.

**Solitude** is the act of being apart from other people totally for a time (Luke 5:16). **Silence** is the practice of stilling our tongue to listen to others and also spend time simply not talking and considering the Lord (Habakkuk 2:20). **Fasting** is to abstain from food to serve the Lord and pray (John 4:34). **Sabbath** is setting a day aside to rest in the Lord Himself and do no spiritual work (Exodus 20:8). **Watching** is abstinence from sleep to pray (Luke 6:12, Psalms 119:62). **Meditation** is to quietly consider some verse, truth, or aspect of the Lord for a period of time (Psalm 48:9, Psalm 46:10). Other more obvious disciplines we can practice are: **Bible Reading, Worship, Prayer, Submission, Personal Introspection, and Service.**

Spiritual disciplines can be looked at like gaining a healthy habit. It takes repetition, time and dedication but the rewards are worth it. A Christianity that does not have spiritual disciplines is a weak, ineffective faith. Seek to grow and "train yourself to be godly" today.

I am asking the church to fast the week of March 13-18, starting on Monday going through Saturday. In preparation, please read your bulletin insert regarding fasting and prayer that I have prepared for you.

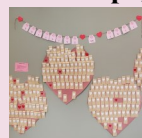

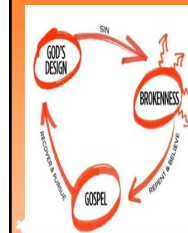

The gospel of Jesus Christ is the most profound reality of life. But sharing it with someone can be as simple as three circles.

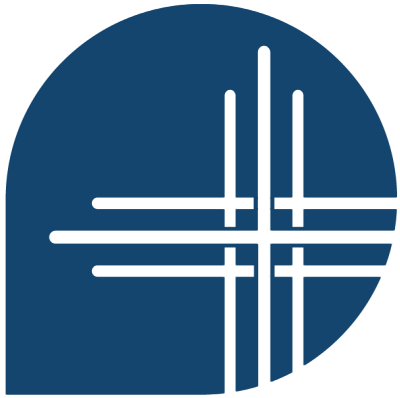
