Good morning, Church,  
I missed worshipping with you last Sunday, however I had a wonderful worship experience at Hanover Baptist Church where we were engaged in mission with Builders for Christ.

**What is a Mission Trip?** A mission trip is an intentional effort of God's people that can be organized by a single church, or a larger group of Christians, who are cooperating together. These trips focus outwardly beyond our church walls to minister to another church or group of people. This term can be applied to a wide variety of endeavors; however, all of these experiences share something in common-- they are motivated by our love for God and our desire to share this love with others. These trips serve a variety of purposes: evangelism, medical needs, teaching, or construction, etc. At times we serve locally and travel a short distance, other times we go further, such as this trip to Hanover, Indiana. And then there are international possibilities, such as when Dee and I went to Thailand to build homes for people who had lost theirs to a disaster.

I have had the privilege of experiencing 4 mission trips and 4 disaster relief trips. I will say that God has every trip in some way to shape and impact my heart. I would encourage each of us to seek an opportunity to go on a mission trip. These are typically not a time of leisure or relaxation but hard work in often uncomfortable surroundings. Yet, we take comfort in knowing that God is with us. If we go with the correct attitude and motivation, God will use us to be a blessing to others.

Special thanks to all of those who went on this trip with a desire to demonstrate God's love to others through the use of our hands and hard work.

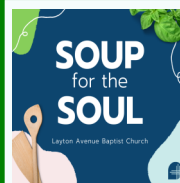

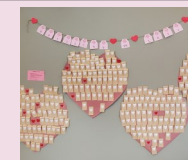

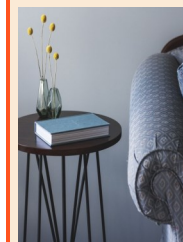
## Host Family Needed
